At the end of the story, Jesus asked who was a neighbor to the hurt man. Someone said, “The one who showed mercy to him!”

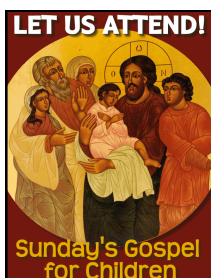
Jesus said, “Go help other people and show them mercy just like the Samaritan did!”

5. What can you do to be like the Good Samaritan?



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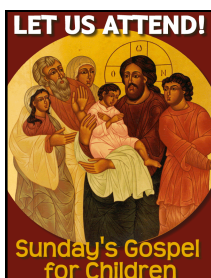
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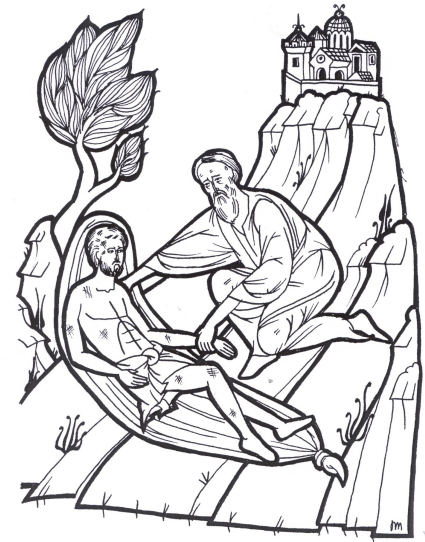
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## JESUS TEACHES US TO CARE FOR OTHERS
