

# St. Gwen of Talgarth, Wales, Virgin-Martyr

*Commemorated on June 22*

St. Gwen of Talgarth, Wales, was the daughter of Brychan of Brecknock and the sister of St. Cledwyn.

She was murdered by the pagan Saxons at Talgarth in 492.

*Troparion (Tone 4) â€œ*

O Brychanâ€™s jewel and holy daughter, most pious Gwena,  
Thou didst defy the heathen Saxons, thereby winning a martyrâ€™s crown.  
Being, therefore, numbered among the saints,  
Intercede for us before the Throne of Grace,  
that we may be granted great mercy.
