~ NAB MID-WINTER MEETING ~

The NAB Antiochian Women Mid-Winter Meeting was held on Saturday February 6, 2021. We were blessed to have Metropolitan JOSEPH with us who led us in prayer and gave his address. He noted his two recent messages; the first in his daily reflections from the Antiochian.org website and the second from his letter for Ladies Month in which he reminds us that we have to endure pain without losing focus or hope. Our Spiritual Life is the Truth; above Death, above life, above money or job; those who endure to the end will be saved. And that through this all we have not lost our faith, our spiritual life has bloomed. Pan-time (as he referenced the time during the pandemic) We are looking for peace and through prayer we find peace.

With regard to our ongoing project, "Fulfilling the Vision, Building a Cathedral at the Antiochian Village", we need to come up with new ways to support our project, to keep this vision alive and help us realize this vision. And lastly he said we need to start educating ourselves and our families to go back to church safely. We have to be leaders and embrace our time in the church.

Other Highlights of the meeting included the approval of the budget for the 2021-2022 year.

Project - It was decided to hold back on the distribution of the Window Clings for Ladies Month until the regulations for limited church attendance are lifted. Project posters and literature will still be sent out to all parishes prior to Ladies Month. *Public Relations* - The Diakonia has been retired and the Antiochian Women will now have a section in every issue of the WORD magazine for News from each Diocese. *Humanitarian* - The Humanitarian coordinator, Lauren Ferris, has noted that we are being asked to promote or consider participation in the Orthodox Christian Prison Ministry this year. She recommended the book "Good News for Captives" on Amazon.

Scholarship - the NAB will be awarding 4 Scholarships for women of the Archdiocese again this year. Information/application forms will be included in the packets we receive for Ladies Month.

Religious - Emily Bradley noted she has been sending out the questions for the Book club selection "Holy Angels" by Mother Alexandra. The book is available from Ancient Faith or Amazon.

Under *New Business*, the NAB Summer Meeting will be held on Saturday July 24, 2021. This meeting will be held via ZOOM since we are forgoing the National Convention this year.

Elections - Because of Covid and the lack of a physical meeting it was decided to forgo formal elections and allow the current slate of officers to continue with their subsequent two year term.

The *Diocese Chapter Reports* were read and the meeting ended with a prayer from Bishop JOHN.

The Ladies of St Mary Church are expanding their listing of online Lenten Recipes. Keep an eye out for some new recipes that will be coming soon. Here are some helpful hints for you.

Egg Replacements:

~1 tsp Baking Soda & 1 Tbsp White Vinegar

~1 Tbsp Ground Flax seed & 3 Tbsp Water – Allow to sit for 5 minutes before using. Can easily be doubled

~1/2 to 1 whole Mashed Banana

~1/2 cup Chick Pea Liquid – Save drained liquid from canned chick peas that you are using

Non-Dairy Milks:

~Soy Milk has been around for many years and there are many butters and yogurt available.

~The Nut milks (Almond, Pecan, cashew) available are wonderful to use in recipes and to be used in coffee and cereals.

~New to the market is Oat Beverage. There is an Extra Creamy that I used for a Cream soup and it worked very well.

~Coconut Milk is also a great product and has been transformed into many different products.

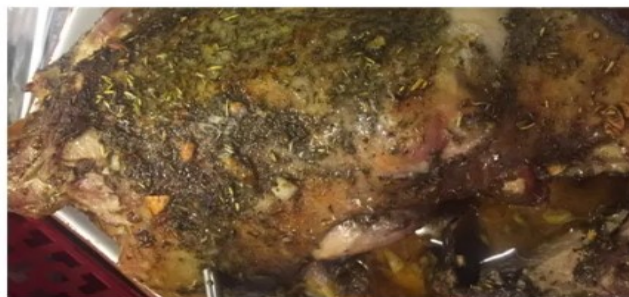
