SESSION I (10:00–12:00 pm) PROMISE & PREPARATION: Finding Christ in the Old Testament

The study of Holy Scripture is a vital part of our life in Christ. Evagrius of Pontus said, "May the rising sun find you with a Bible in your hand." St. John Chrysostom warned his parishioners that it was more necessary for them to read the Scriptures than for monks, because they lived in the midst of the world. In and through the Scriptures, Christ is revealed to us and calls us to follow Him. In his book *Ages of the Spiritual Life*, Paul Evdokimov wrote, "We can say that for the Fathers, the Bible is Christ, for each of its words puts us in his presence...St. Luke's Gospel tells us that Christ opened the minds of his disciples. He showed them how one must read the Bible in order to discover there all that was written concerning him...[and He] revealed that the entire Bible is the verbal icon of Christ."
